

PROFESSIONAL SERVICE CHARGE

OUR LIMITED SERVICE FUNERAL

Carrying out the arrangements and documentation necessary for a very simple cremation or burial service. This funeral will include the provision of the hearse, necessary staff, and local collection of the deceased within normal working hours (Mon to Fri, 9am to 5pm) within a 25 mile radius and the provision of a very simple coffin. The hearse will meet mourners at the cemetery or crematorium, no limousine is provided in this service.

The cost of this service is **£1795.00** plus disbursements.

STANDARDISED PRICE LIST

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary).

ATTENDED FUNERAL (funeral director's charges only) £2745

This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.

Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements **£1205**

Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death **£100**

(normally within 25 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person **£440**

will be kept at one of the funeral director's branch premises.

Providing a suitable coffin – this will be made from a wood effect veneer **£390 +**

Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the **£10**

funeral director (where viewing is requested by the customer)

At a date and time, you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to **£600**

the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 25 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle.

UNATTENDED FUNERAL

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

FEES YOU MUST PAY

For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the **burial fee**.¹ **£420—£169.40**

For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.

For an Attended cremation funeral, the **cremation fee**. **£670—£1070**

² In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.
